The competition clothing consists of a short-sleeved or sleeveless shirt, shorts or skirt, socks and shoes.</li> <li>The main colors of a shirt, skirt or shorts, other them sleeves and collar shall be clearly different from that or the ball in Use</li> <li>Opposing players and pairs shall wear shirts that are of sufficiently different colours to enable them to be easily distinguished by spectators in case have a similar shirt and cannot agree which of them will change the decision shall be made by the umpire by lot</li> <li>Advertisements on uniform must be the size specified by the laws and regulations of The International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF)</li> <li>Problem of uniform in the event to be determined at the discretion of the referee</li> </ol>
